

Recreational Opportunities

Bird Watching – Fishing – Hiking –
Hunting – Outdoor Photography –
Wildlife Viewing

Conservation Areas are closed from 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. except for authorized fishing and hunting, and dog training activities.

- No littering.
- No fireworks.
- No open fires.
- Dogs must be leashed when not used for training or hunting.
- Horseback riding and biking are prohibited off of public roadways.
- Motorized vehicles allowed only on public roadways and parking lots.
- Nuts, berries, fruits, mushrooms and wild greens may be taken for personal use. Cutting or removing other vegetation is prohibited.
- No camping allowed.
- Target shooting is not allowed.

Fishing and Boating

Fishing and frogging are allowed under statewide regulations with the following exceptions:

- Boats may be used only for fishing and water activities and may not be left unattended overnight.

Hunting and Trapping

Hunting is allowed under statewide regulations with the following exceptions:

- Firearms discharging single projectiles are prohibited.
- Deer and turkey regulations are subject to annual changes. Please refer to the Spring Turkey or Fall Deer and Turkey Hunting pamphlets for current regulations.

- Portable tree stands may be used between Sept. 1 and Jan. 31. Stands must be identified with the name and address, or conservation number of the user. Screw-in steps or other materials that would damage the tree are prohibited.

- Decoys and portable blinds are permitted but must be removed from the area daily. Blinds may be constructed on-site, but only from willows and non-woody vegetation.
- Furbearer trapping is permitted by special-use permit.

Driving Directions

From Hwy 76/Hwy 65/Route F intersection, on the north side of Branson, take Route F east 3.4 miles, then Hwy 160 southeast .25 mile, then Hwy 176 south .67 mile to parking lot on west side of Hwy 176.

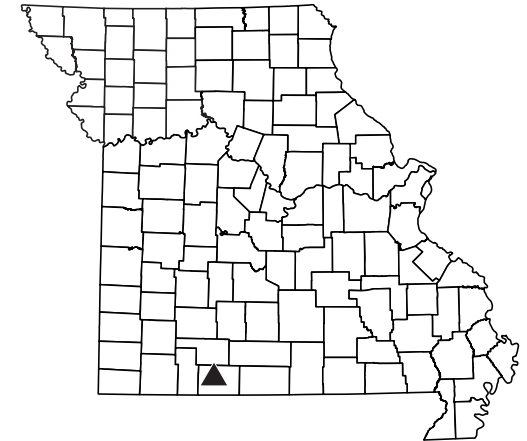
