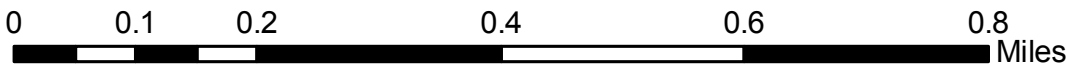
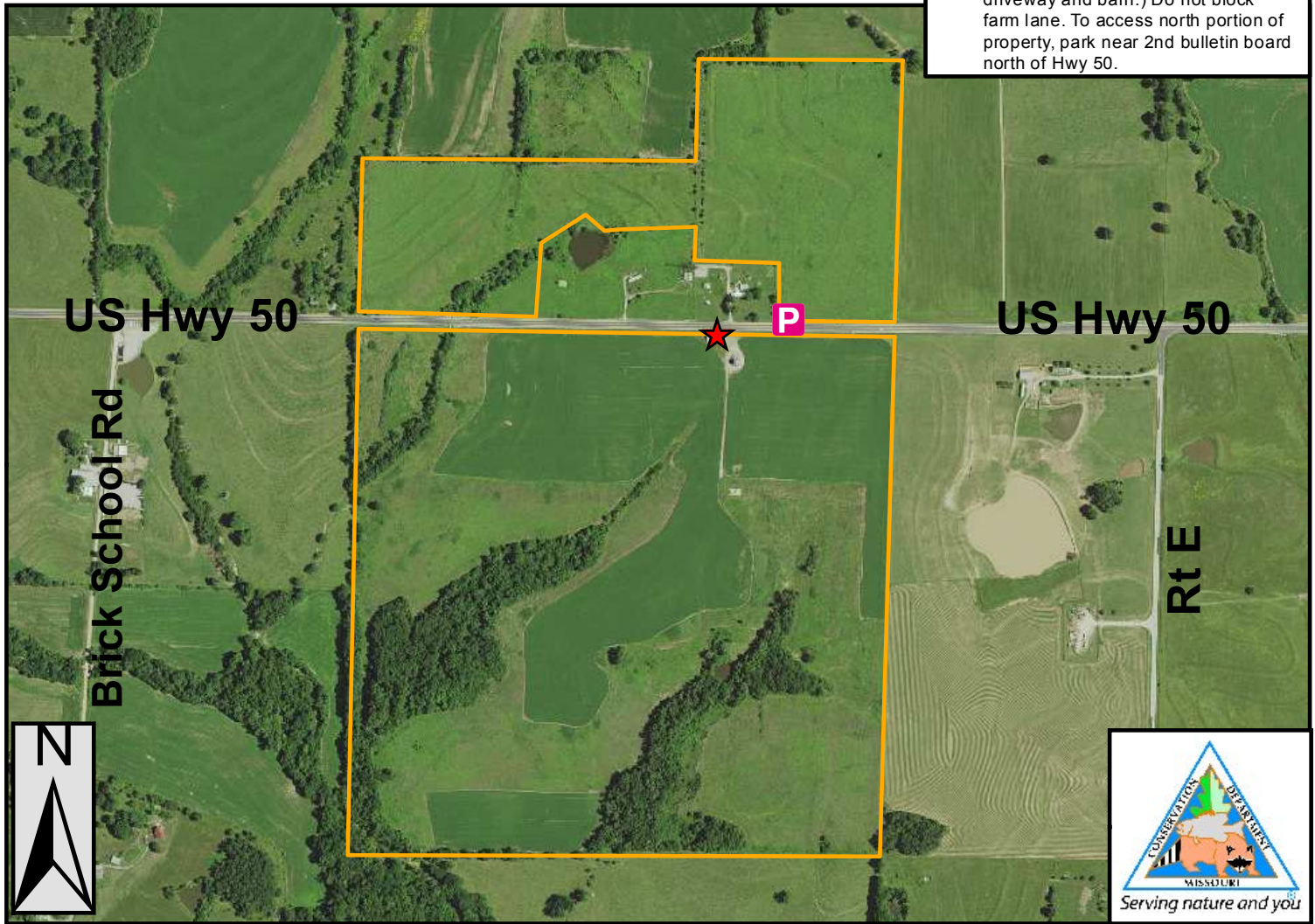
Public Access Type: Small Game & Turkey Hunting

Directions From Tipton:
1) Follow US Hwy 50 east approx. 5 miles
2) Property access will be on right. Turn into farm lane and park near bulletin board (park between driveway and barn.) Do not block farm lane. To access north portion of property, park near 2nd bulletin board north of Hwy 50.
